Riddle Cancer Center, a 10,000 square foot facility located on the ground floor, was designed as an accessible, patient friendly treatment facility for the community.

The Cancer center houses the Radiation Therapy services of the Jefferson Cancer Network, Infusion Services by Riddle Hospital and a private Hematology/Oncology medical practice.

A patient friendly space was created through the thoughtful use of color and natural light. This resulted in a less stressful visit and a pleasant environment while undergoing therapy.

Also included in the new space was a touch-activated computer in the kiosks to provide informational links for patients and their families.
